


Christian Sacrifices



Acts 21:26, Paul Offered A Sacrifice

- ^{NAU} Acts 21:26 Then Paul took the men, and the next day, purifying himself along with them, went into the temple giving notice of the completion of the days of purification, until the sacrifice was offered for each one of them.



Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name. And don't forget to do good and to share with those in need. These are the sacrifices that please God.

Sacrificial Offerings in Leviticus

Voluntary

- Whole Burnt Offering (ch. 1)
- Tribute (grain) Offering (ch. 2)
- Fellowship Offering (ch. 3)

Unintentional Sin

- Offense or Purification Offering (4:1-5:13)
- Reparation Offering (5:14-6:7)



Hebrew: חטָא (chata) = missing the mark or goal

Greek: ἀμάρτημα (hamartia) = missing the mark or goal





- Tenth day of seventh month (Sept/Oct)
- A “sabbath of sabbaths:” complete rest
- “Afflict yourselves:” fasting and other forms of self-denial

Leviticus 16:29-31

THE MEANING OF YOM KIPPUR

- Yom Kippur is the Day of Atonement. The word **Yom** means “**Day**”, and **Kippur** is derived from the Hebrew word Kaphar meaning “**to cover**”.
- So Atonement, means “to cover”.
- On Yom Kippur the high priest was to make “**a covering**” for the sins of Israel committed in the year.

The Two Goats

The Day of Atonement Leviticus 16

- Two goats were chosen (16:5-8)
- One was offered as a sacrifice, and the other was used as a scapegoat (16:8-10)
 - The first goat was sacrificed (16:15-16)
 - The second goat was sent into the wilderness bearing the sins of the people (16:20-22)
- The people were to afflict their souls (23:27-29)



Lev. 16:7-10 Chosen Goat – Tale of Two Goats

Scapegoat – Azazel ... pronounced Ah-ZAY-zel

Leviticus 16:26 several versions ... **goat is GOAT** in Hebrew 🙌😊🙌

Goat to Azazel – Goat as Sent-Away-One – Goat is Scapegoat

Is Goat SENT to Azazel ... as to a Fallen Angel or to a Wilderness?
c. 100 B.C., Jews in Qumran on the Dead Sea wrote about Angel Azazel
Or ... Goat **IS** Azazel ... **IS** Sent-Away-One ... Goat **IS** a Scapegoat?
